Dear Parents/Caregivers,

Outlined below is some information that will help with organisation for the 2019 school year.

School supplies:

- 4 glue sticks
- Pencil case including lead and colour pencils, textas, sharpener and eraser. Please label where possible and maintain regularly to ensure pencils are sharp and supplies are re-stocked.
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 packet of baby wipes
- 1 sheet of cardboard- for an art folder
- 1 plastic A4 envelope for home reading labelled
- 1 paint shirt
- 1 library bag

Please ensure your child has the right equipment ready to start the school year. Young children are still learning to look after their equipment responsibly so please assist by labelling their equipment where possible and checking regularly to see if pencils need sharpening or replacing.

- It is important that your child attends school every day. Please send a note explaining your child's absence immediately upon their return to school. If your child is late to school they must be signed into the front office by a parent or caregiver.
- Supervision does not begin at school until 8:40am. If your child is at school before this time, they must sit on a seat in the playground until the teacher is there to supervise.
- Weekly communication is available through our **newsletter** which is distributed fortnightly on a Wednesday to the youngest child in the family. It is also available on our school website:

- Each day students are encouraged to bring a piece of **fruit** or **vegetable** to have for fruit break. This is a valuable experience for your child and forms an important part of their school day. **Water bottles** are also encouraged in the classroom to ensure children stay hydrated.
