#### Advent Pageant SPECIAL CHRISTMAS SERVICE

This Friday, 26<sup>th</sup> November, the school will be involved in a joyful celebration of sharing the Christmas message with the community of Wallerawang.



Early Stage 1 and Stage 1 will have a quick fruit/drink break then leave the school by bus at 9:30am We will assemble in front of the Butchers for a Pageant down Main Street stopping at several locations to sing a Christmas Carol and share a child centred Christmas message with our local community. The Pageant walk will conclude at Lollipop Junction and the children will return to school by bus for recess.

As we spread the Christmas message parents and younger children are invited to join the Advent Pageant walking down Main Street and/or come to the school for the special service which Stage 1 & 2 are preparing.

#### DRESS – Stage 1 children

The children are asked to wear school uniform with a very simple advent dress up costume over it or some simple hand held props to add atmosphere to the event. Shepherds can have a towel around their head, cloak, Angels – wings or tinsel in their hair. Props to carry could include a star or staff, a baby doll wrapped in a cloth, toy animals as in the stable etc. Please keep it simple and encourage the children to participate. Children with special roles already have a note about their costume.

Stage 1 children will arrive back at school for recess. After recess (11:40am), Stage 1, 2 and Stage 3 children who did not attend the Sydney Excursion will assemble in the hall for a special Christmas Scripture assembly led by Ron and Merle Clark representing Fusion Australia.

### Lunch Arrangements

A sausage sandwich, cake and drink, will be served for lunch to each child who has ordered, progressing through the classes with staff and visitors being served after the children. Cost is \$3.00.

If your child does not wish to order a sausage sandwich they will need to bring their own lunch from home.

The canteen will be available as normal for recess. Parents & Carers are also welcome to join us for lunch.
